CURRENT CORONAVIRUS MEASURES

Covid screening stations are no longer present at Royal Prince Alfred Hospital. However, some guidelines are still in place to help keep one another safe.

PLEASE SEE BELOW REMAINING MEASURES IN:-

- **IF YOU ARE FULLY VACCINATED (AT LEAST 2 DOSES), PLEASE PRESENT YOUR COVID VACCINE CERTIFICATE TO RECEPTION STAFF ON ARRIVAL. IF NOT - EVIDENCE OF A NEGATIVE RAPID ANTIGEN ARE REQUIRED.**
 - If you are a new patient or have not attended since the Covid outbreak, please update your vaccination status on attendance.
 - If not fully vaccinated (at least 2 doses within 14 days of appointment), Rapid Antigen tests need to be done on the morning of your appointment – *please show photo of test done*.
 - If you have already recorded your vaccination status with us, then no further updates are required now.
- **IF YOU ARE EXPERIENCING FLU OR COLD-LIKE SYMPTOMS** – PLEASE RESCHEDULE YOUR APPOINTMENT OR DO A RAPID ANTIGEN TEST BEFORE ATTENDING YOUR APPOINTMENT. (TESTS ARE AVAILABLE FREE OF CHARGE FROM SERVICE NSW).
- **IT IS MANDATORY TO WEAR A MASK AT YOUR APPOINTMENT DUE TO THE INCREASE IN CASES AT PRESENT** - Masks are available at the entrances to the hospital and from our staff at check in, if you do not have one.
- **IF YOU TEST POSITIVE TO COVID PRIOR TO YOUR APPOINTMENT**
As a major health facility, Royal Prince Alfred Hospital is considered a High Risk setting, therefore you need to allow 8 days from the day you are diagnosed/test positive, before you can attend a rescheduled appointment symptom-free. This includes any companions. If you are not sure, please contact us.

PLEASE BE AWARE THAT ADVICE CAN CHANGE AT SHORT NOTICE IF THERE IS A COVID SPIKE, THEREFORE IT IS IMPORTANT TO KEEP UP TO DATE WITH CURRENT HEALTH ADVICE.

We have developed these measures from guidelines set out by the Department of Health, and continue to review them, for the safety of yourself, other patients, and staff. Thank you for your co-operation.
