TO MANAGE EXPOSURE TO POSSIBLE CONTACT, PLEASE FOLLOW THE INFORMATION LISTED:

- **IF YOU ARE A NEW PATIENT, OR HAVE NOT ATTENDED SINCE THE COVID OUTBREAK, WE WOULD APPRECIATE YOU ADVISING OUR STAFF IF YOU HAVE BEEN VACCINATED AND PROVIDE LAST VACCINE DETAILS.** **Rapid Antigen tests no longer need to be performed prior to an appointment.**
- **IF YOU ARE EXPERIENCING FLU OR COLD-LIKE SYMPTOMS – PLEASE RESCHEDULE YOUR APPOINTMENT.**
- **GOVERNMENT GUIDELINES HAVE BEEN RELAXED REGARDING MASKS** - therefore, it is preferred you wear a mask in the waiting room, and at your appointment, but it is not mandatory. **Masks are available at the main entrance of the hospital or at our reception areas, please ask a staff member if you need one.**
- **PAYMENTS FOR CONSULTATIONS BY CARD ONLY ARE STILL PREFERRED.** To minimise risk of contact we are encouraging payment by card still. Please be aware that if you are intending to pay in cash, exact change is advisable, as we have limited change due to increased card payments.
- **There is hand sanitiser available** in the waiting room to use after visiting the bathroom or sneezing, coughing, etc.
